- Mold mitigation
- Home weatherization
- Pest control
- Tree trim/removal
- Steam clean carpeting
- Air conditioner filter replacement
- Provide family with a "Healthy Home Kit" with home improvement products

TYPICAL REPAIRS FOR THE ROOF REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

- Roof repair
- Roof replacement

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- Must live in Unincorporated Hillsborough County, City of Tampa, City of Temple Terrace, or Plant City
- Property must be owner occupied and homesteaded
- Must own home for at least 2 years
- Must be current on mortgage, property taxes, HOA fees, and assessments
- No personal or property judgments
- Must be a single family dwelling, condo, or townhome
- Be within HUD income limits:
